

*Go Wild!* April 21<sup>st</sup> at the Berwyn Public Library!

Please join us on Wednesday, April 21, 2004, at 7:00 pm in the Community Room for our long anticipated *Go Wild!* program. Our speaker, Leslie Cummings is a Habitat Host with the Backyard Wildlife Program of the National Wildlife Federation. She will share with us how with just a little careful planning we can convert our backyards into nature refuges that will provide shelter, water and food for native plants, animals and birds as well as years of enjoyment for our families.

Berwyn's population has grown by more than 10,000 people between the 1990 and 2000 census—an increase that is contributing to the loss of habitat and decline of natural resources for our native species. The National Wildlife Federation's Backyard Wildlife Program is a creative way to address this problem. Begun in 1973 in response to America's continuing urbanization, the program has aided native species that are in danger of being displaced.

The only limit is our imagination. With the help NWF's free planning guide, *The Backyard Wildlife Habitat Starter Kit*, which is full of tools and ideas to inspire us, we will learn to take part in a fun family activity that can be as simple or elaborate as we choose.
