Grant \$100,000 to the Berwyn Park District
In partnership to keep
Local Children off Drugs and Away from Gangs and Crime



The City of Berwyn, the Berwyn Police Department and the Berwyn Park District have combined their efforts to reduce crime, improve the quality of life, and keep children away from drugs. Through drug money confiscated by the Berwyn Police Department and other federal agencies, the Berwyn Park District is constructing a new Skate Park Facility at Smirz Park, located at 34th Street and Highland Avenue. The new skate park facility, designed to provide alternatives to drugs and gangs, is scheduled to open in the summer of 2002. This partnership between the Berwyn Park District, the City of Berwyn, and the Berwyn Police Department is a continuing example of positive cooperative agreements between local agencies. Through the efforts of Mayor Thomas G. Shaughnessy and Director of Public Safety Frank Marzullo the residents of Berwyn are receiving a new facility, new opportunities, and an improved quality of life.
